#### COMPLETED APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY 5.30pm Monday 15<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2015

The National Carbon Cocky Awards are open to all landholders and others in Australia who are achieving excellence in Carbon Farming and Emissions Reduction techniques which deliver improved soil carbon sequestration and water management OR who have developed innovative techniques OR inventions to improve farm based carbon storage OR emissions reduction .

### NATIONAL CARBON COCKY of THE YEAR Award

This Award will be presented to the primary producer or landholder who has demonstrated overall excellence in understanding, implementing and achieving outstanding results in the management of land based carbon storage and carbon emission reductions.

### How do you apply yourself OR nominate another landholder?

#### **Applications**

All applications submitted by landholders or businesses are required to demonstrate how they have met the judging criteria, or are working towards meeting the criteria. Please keep your submissions clear and concise. To be eligible you do not have to fulfil every criterion. These are listed as a guide. All nominations are welcome.

#### Assessment

A Carbon Farmers of Australia (CFA) representative will contact you regarding your application. Your application is then forwarded to an independent expert panel for assessment.

You will be assessed against a standard set of criteria to determine your potential to deliver improved soil carbon, water management OR your creativity in developing innovative techniques or inventions to improve farm based sequestration or emissions reduction OR assess the positive outcomes achieved as a result of the support and product your business delivers to landholders.

#### When will the Award Winners be announced?

- The judges will choose up to 5 Finalists for eight of the Awards with selection criteria. All Finalists will be invited to attend the National Carbon Cocky Gala Awards Dinner... to be held on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July in Albury, as the social event of the Carbon Farming Conference & Expo 2015. Finalists of each Award will be presented with a Certificate on stage, and then the Winner of each Award will be announced and presented with a personalised trophy and product and/or services Gift Voucher courtesy of the Award Sponsor.
- The winners of the other four Awards will be selected from the total pool of applications received.



### National CARBON COCKY AWARD For Outstanding Achievement in SOIL CARBON SEQUESTRATION

This award will be presented to a primary producer or landholder involved in primary production who demonstrates a measured increase in soil carbon levels... and has adopted land management practices that are recognised to increase soil carbon.

### Judging Criteria

To be eligible you do not have to fulfil every criterion. These are listed as a guide. All nominations are welcome.

1. The applicant has achieved successful adoption of innovative practices that are generally recognised to increase soil carbon levels and that deliver improved productivity, and demonstrate the principles that need to be used in land management to increase soil carbon levels

Eg: • Ground cover • Perenniality • Balanced nutrition • Soil management • Biodiversity... in pasture species and rotation of crops

- 2. The applicant can measure increases in soil carbon levels. OR demonstrate innovative practices OR activities that delivers improved productivity and commercial outcomes while at the same time is improving natural resource management. If possible attach records for judges' information
- 3. The applicant has implemented restoration of the productive capacity of the soil.
- 4. The applicant has demonstrated commitment to the long term health and performance of the soil.
- 5. The applicant has adopted a learning attitude towards biosequestration and biodiversity.

### National CARBON COCKY AWARD For Outstanding Achievement in INCREASED TREE / NATIVE VEGETATION CARBON SEQUESTRATION

This award will be presented to a primary producer, landholder or group involved in major vegetation improvement who demonstrates a measured increase in tree carbon levels and restored native vegetation... and has adopted land management practices to ensure carbon levels will be built and maintained.

#### Judging Criteria

To be eligible you do not have to fulfil every criterion. These are listed as a guide. All nominations are welcome.

- 1. The applicant can measure increases in tree carbon levels or has implemented planning processes or projects to increase tree carbon levels. If possible attach records for judges' information.
- 2. The applicant has implemented planning processes or projects to achieve restoration of native vegetation and the productive capacity of the land.
- 3. The applicant has demonstrated commitment to the long term health and performance of natural resources including trees.
- 4. The applicant has adopted a learning attitude towards natural resource management and shown leadership in encouraging the farming community to engage with natural resource improvements.

# National CARBON COCKY AWARD For Outstanding PRODUCT OF THE YEAR

This award will be presented to a business or organisation who has developed a product and/or processes to improve natural resource management and/or land based carbon storage or emissions reduction.

### Judging Criteria

To be eligible you do not have to fulfil every criterion. These are listed as a guide. All nominations are welcome.

- 1. The applicant has successfully developed a product or a service/process that delivers improved productivity and commercial outcomes in farm operations, improves natural resource management and or reduces emissions. This can be demonstrated by:
  - i. Development of products and/or services not previously applied to primary production;
  - ii. Delivering products and/or services for primary production that were previously only being researched;
  - iii. Developing products and/or services that will improve productivity and natural resource management outcomes.
  - iv. Inventing or pioneering new products and/or services which could increase soil carbon levels and/or emissions reduction.
- 2. The applicant has shared their discoveries with the agricultural community.
- 3. The applicant is committed to supporting land and other sectors to achieving long term health of the soil, increasing soil sequestration and/or reducing emissions.

# <u>AWARD 4</u> National CARBON COCKY AWARD For Outstanding INNOVATION OR INVENTION

This award will be presented to a primary producer or landholder involved in primary production add in who implements innovative practices or an invention to improve natural resource management and land based carbon storage.

### Judging Criteria

To be eligible you do not have to fulfil every criterion. These are listed as a guide. All nominations are welcome.

- 1. The applicant has successfully adopted innovative practices or activities that delivers improved productivity and commercial outcomes while at the same time is improving natural resource management
- 2. The applicant has implemented innovative practices that will improve productivity outcomes in t farm operations. This can be demonstrated by:
  - v. Use of techniques not previously applied in their geographic area to primary production;
  - vi. Application of practices in primary production that were previously only being researched;
  - vii. Developing techniques that will improve productivity and natural resource management outcomes.
  - viii. Inventing or pioneering new techniques and practices which could increase soil carbon levels and soil health.
- 3. The applicant has shared their discoveries with the agricultural community.
- 4. The applicant demonstrates a commitment to the long term health and performance of the soil.
- 5. The applicant has adopted a learning attitude towards biosequestration and biodiversity...... co-operating with nature... understanding the landscape and practising and managing agriculture ecological systems on their land.

## National CARBON COCKY AWARD For Outstanding LEADERSHIP

This award will be presented to a primary producer or landholder involved in primary production who demonstrates a learning attitude and sharing their knowledge of sustainable farming practices and increased land based carbon storage.

### **Judging Criteria**

To be eligible you do not have to fulfil every criterion. These are listed as a guide. All nominations are welcome.

- 1. Inspirational leadership in the education and advocacy of carbon farming in Australia.
- 2. Deliver a positive pathway to achieve best farm practice and increased land based carbon storage.
- 3. Facilitation of partnerships between farmers, industry, NRM regional bodies, Landcare, government and communities... sharing knowledge on carbon farming science management and/or policy.
- 4. Making a positive contribution by giving time and energy to mentor and provide encouragement to others.
- 5. Developing successful enterprises or opportunities to build stronger farming communities
- 6. Formed partnerships, sought advice and worked with others to promote soil health as a worthwhile focus for any farmer.
- 7. Demonstrating by their actions a sense of responsibility for promoting the role of soil carbon in sustainable agriculture.
- 8. Earn recognition and respect from peers for their contribution and knowledge.

- 2. Adapt new technologies and practices that reduce Green House Gases emissions
- 3. Demonstrate commitment to long term reduction in Green House Gases emissions.

### National CARBON COCKY AWARD For Outstanding Achievement by a NON PRIMARY PRODUCER IN EMISSIONS REDUCTION

#### **Judging Criteria**

To be eligible you do not have to fulfil every criterion. These are listed as a guide. All nominations are welcome.

- 1. Adapt new technologies and practices that reduce Green House Gases emissions
- 2. Install and monitor new systems that reduce Green House Gases emissions
- 3. Develop positive environment product/s of benefit to the soil and/or improve environmental management
- 4. Demonstrate commitment to long term reduction in Green House Gases emissions in the agriculture industry

## National CARBON COCKY AWARD For Outstanding Performance in CARBON TRADING PROJECT MANAGEMENT
