CROSS PROPERTY PROJECT (CPP)

The CPP has involved 3 landcare groups and achieved 797 ha of natives planted, 695ha of existing native plants protected, 67km of fencing installed, 11806 ha managed for weeds, 23,995ha managed for pests and conducted 52 workshops and field days over 6 years!
