

AGRITOURISM BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**

Riverina Regional Tourism is currently implementing a regional agritourism development program, which encompasses product development and marketing activity. The overarching vision is to develop the Riverina region as a must visit food, fibre and agricultural region, which provides visitors with an opportunity to learn about food and fibre production whilst enjoying the regional produce at the same time.

Riverina Regional Tourism has a goal of seeing four new agritourism products/experiences launched in 2014. Following is a summary of some of the gaps and preferred products and experiences that RRT has identified via an agritourism audit.

- Farm Gate Sales
- Farm and Factory tours, which allow visitors to experience production of the regions diverse food and fibre production
- Farm stay accommodation
- Pick your own experiences
- Agriculture based events
- Visitor Interpretation Centres Irrigation, Rice, Cotton, etc.
- Providores

A key program in supporting to bring these products/experiences to fruition is a 3-month business-mentoring program. This will involve linking projects and entrepreneurs with a series of mentors that can support them through the challenges and barriers to development.

- Mid program meeting with RRT Product Development Officer

October:

- Review of progress, and official launch of new products and experiences during Taste Riverina
- Mentoring continues
- Celebration dinner with the RRT Board, Mentors and all Participants
- New products and experiences listed on Visit NSW, Riverina Tourism and further marketing websites

November:

Program finalised
