Based on the feedback from the successful *Outshine the Swine* field day held in Adjungbilly in February this year, a co-ordinated feral pig control program is about to begin in your area.

Tumut Shire Council, in partnership with the Hume Livestock Health and Pest Authority, Murrumbidgee Catchment Management Authority and NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service has received funding through the Australian Government Caring for Our Country Program to develop and co-ordinate a feral pig control program.

A follow up field day is organised to:

- explain how the co-ordinated program will be conducted
- outline the role of the various agencies involved, including the Rural Crime Force
- provide demonstrations on how to set up the control program on your property
- distribute materials such as traps and baits to undertake a control program.
